No ID? You can apply for free voter ID

A General Election will be held on **Thursday 4 July 2024** to choose local Members of Parliament and form a UK Government.

To vote at a polling station, you will need photo ID with you. A wide range of photo ID will be accepted, including passports, driving licences, bus passes and cards with a PASS Mark.

If you don't have what's needed, you can apply for a free voter ID document known as a Voter Authority Certificate. Visit electoralcommission.org.uk/voterID, call **0800 328 0280**, or scan the QR code to find out more, including:

These changes apply to all elections going forward.

- ▶ Deadline to register to vote – **Tuesday 18 June, midnight**
- ▶ Deadline to apply for a Voter Authority Certificate if you have no other acceptable photo ID – **Wednesday 26 June, 5pm**
- ▶ Deadline to apply for a postal vote – **Wednesday 19 June, 5pm**
