The Burial Board was created by the Parish Councils of Great Hale and Little Hale in the 1890s; it reports back to the Parishes annually but Trustees are no longer required to be appointed by the Parish Councils. Because of this disassociation, the Burial Board is not eligible to re-claim VAT under the Parish Councils' arrangements with HMRC, nor is it subject to the Smaller Bodies Annual External Audit regime. The Board continues to report annually to the Charity Commission. During 2024-25, the Board agreed to investigate setting up a Charitable Incorporated Organisation to regularise its constitution and work on that is ongoing.

The Burial Board's stated activities are to provide the area and maintain the same for the burials of present & past inhabitants of the two parishes. The cemetery also provides a place for people to visit the graves of loved ones.

During 2024-25 the Board continued to undertake work parties for seasonal maintenance as required. The contract with PJ Haynes of Waddington for the regular cutting of the grass in the Cemetery was terminated after the first two cuts in 2025 at Mr Haynes' request. For the rest of the year, grass cutting was undertaken by Trustees themselves, for which the Board was extremely grateful. However this was clearly not sustainable so a new contractor was sought and an arrangement negotiated with Sleaford Town Council for the 2025 season.

The Board met twice formally, in April 2024 and November 2024, and once informally, using either Parva House in Little Hale, or Mr Needham's office at Home Farm, Little Hale.

Burials were carried out and paid for during the year by local Funeral Director JE Severs (2), and payment was not received by the end of the year for a further one. Memorial applications by Wm Kent (4), Dignity (1) and Set In Stone (1) were approved. In addition, one further plot was purchased privately for future use.

The first interest payment on the 5-year fixed-term bond with Cambridge & Counties Bank, opened in January 2024, was received in February 2025.

The Board appreciates the support it has received from Great Hale and Little Hale Parish Councils towards its grass-cutting costs up to 2024 and welcomes the new arrangement with the Parish Councils to meet the higher costs of the Sleaford Town Council contract in 2025.
