

HALE MAGNA AND HALE PARVA CEMETERY

Rules and Regulations

Planting of shrubs and trees is not allowed on the plots/grave spaces

Curbing stones around the plots/grave spaces are not allowed

All memorials are to be kept in line with the existing headstones

All interments are to be kept central to the plot/grave space

The levelling of plots/graves is the responsibility of the family

The process of consecrating plots/grave spaces is the responsibility of the family

All plots/grave spaces measure (4feet by 8feet 9inches) 1metre 25cms by
2metres 70cms in size unless special requirements are needed

The Burial Board does not permit double depth graves in the cemetery extension

The headstones should not be any larger than the following statement:

The total area taken by single headstones should be a maximum height of
(3feet) 90cms and no wider the (3feet 6inches) 1metre 10cms

The total area taken by double headstones should be a maximum height of
(3feet) 90cms and no wider than (7feet) 2metres 13cms

The maximum size of a vase, only as an alternative to a headstone should be no more
than (12inches by 8inches by 10inches) 30.48cms by 20.32cms by 25.40cms

Cremated remains must be interred and not scattered on the grave

Dogs must be kept on leads when in the cemetery
