Killed in Action Flanders 29th October 1914

Killed in Action France 2nd June 1917 age 25

Buried Bois-Carre British Cemetery, Thelus. Grave II.B.7.

Son of Francis and Mary Ann Key of Great Hale

Born Great Hale. Resided Heckington. Enlisted Plumstead, London.

Killed in Action Passchendaele, Flanders 26th October 1917 age 23

Sergeant ASHBOURNE DELANEY SHAW MM

Husband of Mrs G M Shaw of Great Hale Vicarage

Born Swineshead. Enlisted Boston.

Died of Wounds France 5th October 1917 age 31

Buried Etaples Military Cemetery, France. Grave XXVII.F.14

Born Sleaford. Resident Heckington. Enlisted Spilsby.
Killed in Action Gallipoli 9th August 1915 Age 18
Commemorated on Helles Memorial, Turkey. Panel 44 to 46

Corporal JOHN WILLIAM WARD

15220 1st Battalion Lincolnshire Regiment
Son of Speed and Hannah Ward of Little Hale
Born Heckington. Resided Heckington. Enlisted Sleaford.
Killed in Action Passchendaele, Flanders 4th October 1917 Age 27
Commemorated Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium. Panel 35-37 & 162-162A.
